Two global competitions have been held and a special website created to showcase the outcomes of the students' efforts: see www.disarmamenthub.org.

This year WFUNA's program for Students for a Nuclear Weapons Free-World aims to tap into the energy and creativity of the digital generation to invigorate world-wide campaigning to free the world of nuclear weapons. A competition will be held to champion the best ideas, in terms of both content and process, for student-led campaigns (at either local, regional or global levels) for a nuclear weapons-free world.

The competition will be conducted over a period of three months: May - July 2009. Submissions are to be sent to hub@wfuna.org.

Consistent with the aim of nourishing and supporting young people to engage with disarmament issues at the United Nations, winners will be invited to present their campaign proposals at the UN NGO/DPI Conference on Disarmament in Mexico, 9-11 September 2009 or at the Video Conference being convened by the Project for Nuclear Awareness in October 2009.
