• UTE


- Two separate communities: researchers vs teachers

3 levels of development towards the future education

- institutional
- pedagogical
- scientific

1. The institution level

How to guarantee the openness vis-à-vis of the external society and to favour emerging pedagogies oriented by contextual changes?




Teacher-researchers, Student-researchers

2. The pedagogical level



How to adapt the system to shift from subject to people activities / competencies, as well as from academic to academic/contextual knowledge?

- Situatedness
 - as a central dimension of learning
- Rethinking *evaluation*



3. The scientific level



How to integrate the relevance of innovation (creativity, artefacts, technology) to overcome disciplinary and curricular barriers?
